We are very excited to be holding our annual Lobbying Conference in Albany. The many issues we will be lobbying on will include but are not limited to the following: Unemployment, Student Loan Assistance, TDI, NY Health Act, Union Made in NY, Property Tax Freeze for Seniors, and the Empire Act.

Hotel Information: The Conference will take place at the Hilton Albany located at 40 Lodge Street, Albany, NY 12207. A block of rooms has been set aside at a rate of \$204.06 per night (\$179 + \$25.06 tax).

FEBRUARY 27, 2026, is the cutoff for hotel rooms.
