

MDA-UAW LOCAL 571 JOHN F. SAFFOMILLA AND E. ROY COLVILLE SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE January 28, 2025

The MDA-UAW Local 571 is pleased to announce the availability of ten (10) annual John F. Saffomilla and E. Roy Colville Scholarship Awards of \$3,000.00 each to graduating high school seniors, pursuing a higher education, who meet the qualifying guidelines.

Eligibility to apply for these scholarship awards is limited to graduating high school seniors whose parent or legal guardian is a Local 571 member in good standing. Applications for the scholarship awards for 2025 are available from your **Grievance Representative** and available on our web site at: **region9a.uaw.org/local 571**.

The following guidelines will prevail in selecting the recipients and awarding the scholarships:

- All applications must be received by <u>mail only</u>, at the MDA-UAW Local 571 Office, P. O. Box 7275, Groton, CT 06340 Attn: Recording Secretary, no later than Friday, April 25, 2025. No hand-carried applications will be accepted.
- 2. All timely applications will be reviewed and ten recipients will be selected by an impartial committee of three nonmembers of the Union. Incomplete or late applications will not be processed.
- 3. the scholarship awards will consist of ten (10) awards of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) each.
- 4. One (1) runner-up will be selected by the impartial committee in the event one of the winners becomes disqualified.
- 5. Upon proof of enrollment, the \$3,000.00 awards will be mailed directly to the college that each winner attends.

Each student applicant's high school academic and social achievements are the most important considerations in choosing the winners; however, it should be noted that in the selection process a significant emphasis and/or tie breaker factor will be placed on the financial need of the students.

Student applicants should take care to provide all the information requested of them on the application form. Additionally, they should check with their high school guidance departments in sufficient time prior to the deadline to ensure that their school has forwarded the required data to our scholarship committee. The deadline for the return of application forms and supporting data from school guidance departments is Friday, April 25, 2025 and this is firm.
